

Agenda

The agenda is designed to provide an understanding of the content and the process of delivering fathering. Each program has a limited number of participants per session to increase individual interaction with instructors and other participants.

Day 1

- Workshop participants will experience NCF's father-equipping program as a participant. Presented by NCF Instructors.
- Participants and NCF instructor will discuss program content and processes from an instructor's perspective. Instructor and participants will review the instructor's guides and discuss all materials contained in the guides. Presentation and facilitation skills will be reviewed and discussed.
- Each participant will be given an assignment for that evening to prepare a brief presentation on a short segment of the fathering program to be presented Day 2.

Day 2

- Each participant will 1) learn and use a feedback model 2) practice their presentation skills and receive feedback. Each participant will deliver a brief presentation on a section of the fathering program content reviewed in Session 1 and receive feedback on their presentation skills and impact.
- The effective handling of specific audience issues and challenges will be discussed.
- Participants will finalize 1) their instructor development plan and 2) establish next steps to implement their father equipping activities
