10 Tips for Talking to Your Son About Girls

- Set a good example for your son by the way you treat his mother. He needs you to model a healthy relationship so he can follow in your footsteps.
- Start the discussion early on so it is a comfortable topic between the two of you. Let the first messages about sex be from you, so he can trust them.
- Be honest about your expectations of your son. Discuss your family's values and why they are important.

- Answer his questions. You would rather him come to you with questions than turn to outside sources who may not hold the same values as you.
- Have a discussion about respect. Not just respecting girls in his life, but respecting himself as well.
- Be accepting of his feelings.
 He shouldn't be embarrassed about the way he feels about girls, he just may need some guidance on how to react to those feelings.

Understand that aggressive girls will likely come into your son's life. Have conversations about what he wants in a potential spouse so he can tell the difference.

- Include mom! Obviously you will, and should be, the go to for these conversations. But she can provide insights into a girl's mind that you can't.
- Discuss sex in terms of accountability. Be honest about the repercussions from an unhealthy sex life.
- Let him know that you are available. While you are his father, and there to provide standards and guidance, you are also his friend and are there to listen.
